Rates

Hair/what to wear to class

Dancers hair should be off their face and in pony tails. Please include some elastics and some hair clips in their dance bag. Also wear shorts and t-shirts, and dance socks too. Dancers are encouraged to wear their shoes for the entire class. We do not want anyone slipping in their socks.

Dance dresses and dance shoes

All dancers who do not have a school dress should be talking to their teacher to see if we have any 2nd hand costumes to fit, and if not ordering a new dress from our seamstress. There is a selection of dresses for all to try. Dresses need to fit the dancer and they should not be below their knee.

All dancers should also have proper shoes and socks for class. Again, talk to your teacher. Our parent volunteer has second hand shoes.
